RE: 1,400 acre ("Camp 4") fee-to-trust application, Santa Ynez Band of Mission Chumash Indians

Dear Ms. Amy Dutschke,

On behalf of myself, and Preservation of Los Olivos, P.O.L.O., I request **a copy** of the amended/revised fee-to-trust application on "Camp 4" (approximately 1,400 acres, Santa Ynez, Ca.) by the Santa Ynez Band of Mission Chumash Indians and 30 days in which to comment.

As our community understands it, the IBIA vacated the BIA's approved Santa Ynez Band of Mission Chumash Indian's Tribal Land Consolidation and Acquisition Plan (TLCA). Because the Santa Ynez Band's fee-to-trust application was based on the TLCA, the Santa Ynez Band will have to amend their application on "Camp 4". This amendment will change the application and thus, **for due process reasons**, all stakeholders must be allowed the opportunity to review it and given 30 days to comment.
